# Northern Neck Corvette Club By-Laws

### **Article I: Name**

- 1. The name shall be: Northern Neck Corvette Club (NNCC)
- 2. The name and club logo shall be used exclusively by the club unless special permission is granted by the club.
- 3. The NNCC Website is: northerneckcorvetteclub.com

# **Article II: Membership**

- 1. Any person of good character who owns a Corvette(s) or is interested in Corvettes may join this club provided: they plan to participate in club activities and appropriately fill out the NNCC membership form.
- 2. The conduct of all members shall be the same as a good citizen. Any questionable conduct shall be subject to review by the club officers.

# **Article III: Meetings and Events**

- 1. The date, time and location of Membership meeting and Board meetings are posted on the NNCC website.
- 2. The date, time and location of Club Events are posted on the NNCC website.

#### **Article IV: Officers and Duties**

- 1. The Board of Directors shall consist of: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and two Members-at-Large. Liaison Board Member positions may be created as needed.
- 2.Liaison Board Members are usually an Executive Board Member of another car club. Liaison Board Members are a non voting position strictly advisory in nature.
- 3.The term of the officers shall be for two years. The formal vote for officer positions will take place at the November Annual Meeting. Terms will begin the following January 1<sup>st</sup> of the new year and end exactly two years later.
- 4. The Roles and Responsibilities of the Officers are stated on the titled document, accessible via the NNCC website.
- 5. Additional Non-Board positions may be established by the Board as necessary.

#### **Article V: Club Finances**

- 1.Club finances shall be handled by the NNCC Treasurer.
- 2. The Club checking account shall have two authorized signatories: the Treasurer and one other appointed Board member.
- 3.The Club does not collect dues. Funds are raised by event 50/50 raffles and the raffle of donated items from Club Sponsors or members.
- 4. An audit should be performed annually.

### **Article VII: By-Law Amendments**

1.Proposed amendments to the By-Laws should be presented in writing to the President who will present them to the Board of Directors for action. A simple majority of the membership at a duly constituted meeting is required to pass an amendment to the By-Laws.
